HOW TO COLLABORATE WITH SUGGESTED READING

Tell your peers and scientists from other fields about textbooks, scientific articles, or even works of fiction that have sparked your interest, made you smile, or somehow impacted you. This space is for recommending reading material as you would among friends, sharing (in the first person) what you most enjoyed about the text, the most important details, and why it is worth reading.

Procedure

Send your suggestion to science.arena@einstein.br. We will get back to you after assessing your proposal. Your email must include:

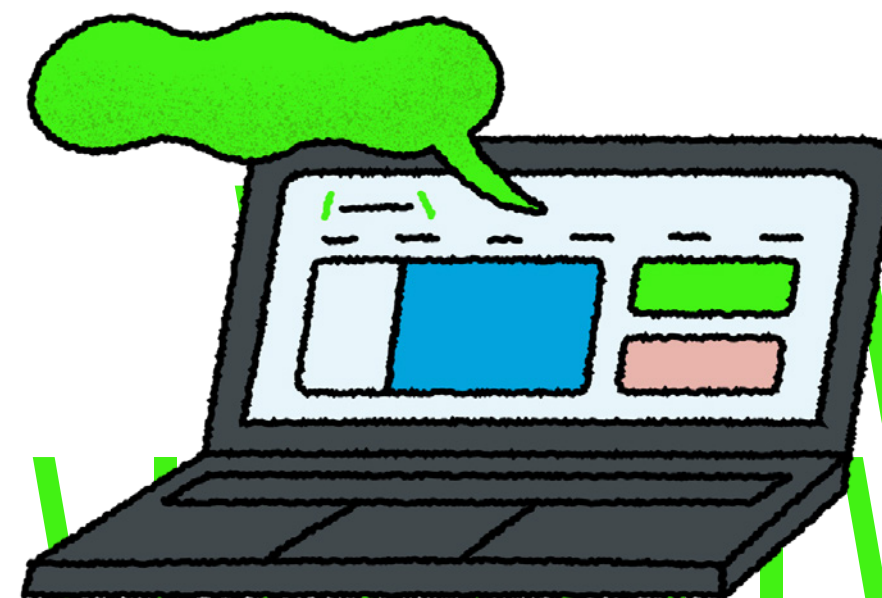
- The title of the article or book you are recommending.
- Why it is worth reading.

Length

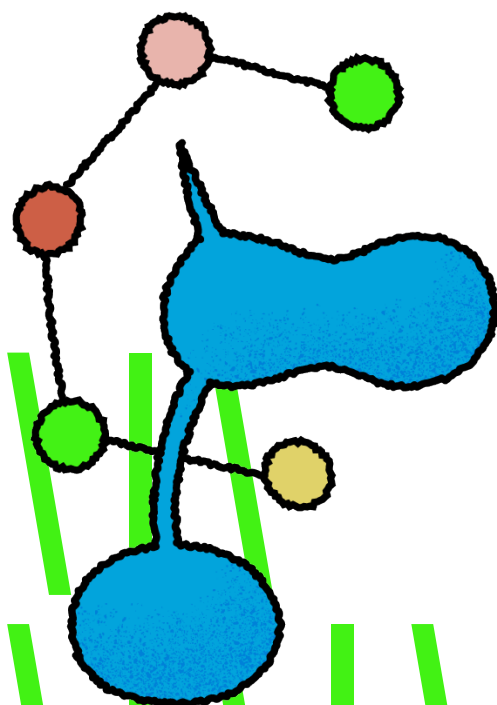
Approximately 500 words (or up to 1 page in Word).

WHAT ELSE YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT OUR PUBLICATION PROCESS



■ If your proposed contribution is accepted, we will send you a Collaboration Agreement by email. This document outlines the responsibilities of the author and **Science Arena** and provides guidance on legal issues relating to plagiarism and third-party rights. Please read the agreement carefully, then sign it and send it back to us (digital signatures are accepted).

■ Your text may be screened by automatic plagiarism detection software.

■ The content must be exclusive, original, of good scientific and academic quality, and free from plagiarism, meaning it must not have been previously published on other news sites, institutional websites, social media, scientific journals, conference annals, or any other publication.

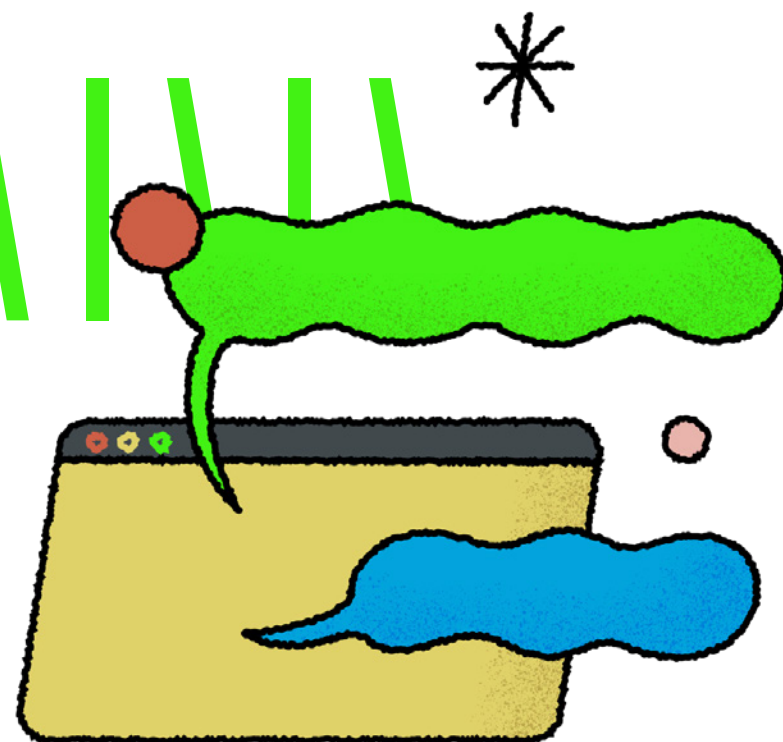
■ Our team of journalists will review the text and propose adjustments, if necessary, to make it more attractive and accessible. For example, we may recommend that extremely technical terms be explained and that jargon be replaced with simpler synonyms.

■ The text should not exceed 1,200 words in total.

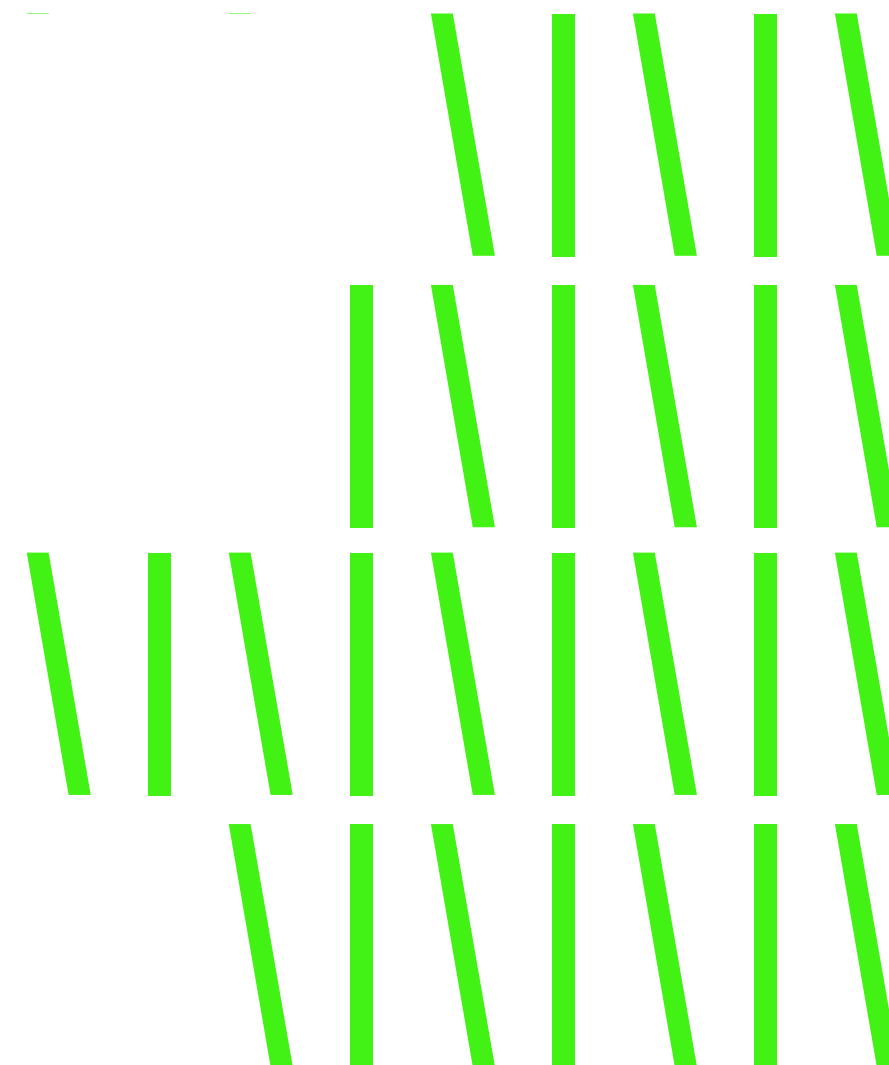
■ Authors must declare possible conflicts of interest in advance.

■ Authors must be linked to a research institution. PhD students can submit articles to **Science Arena** with the collaboration of a supervisor. We do not publish essays by master's students.

WHAT YOU GET OUT OF IT



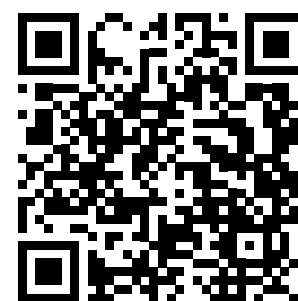
- We publish your text after you have given final approval of the revised version. We believe in developing strong partnerships between journalists and researchers.
- We allow you to republish the text on digital media, as long as due credit is given to **Science Arena**, including a link to the original publication.
- We provide a translation of the text into English. Our translators are native English speakers with expertise in medical and scientific fields.
- We provide exclusive, personalized material so that you can promote your essay among your networks.
- We promote and share the text on our social media pages, managed by Einstein's Institutional Communication team.

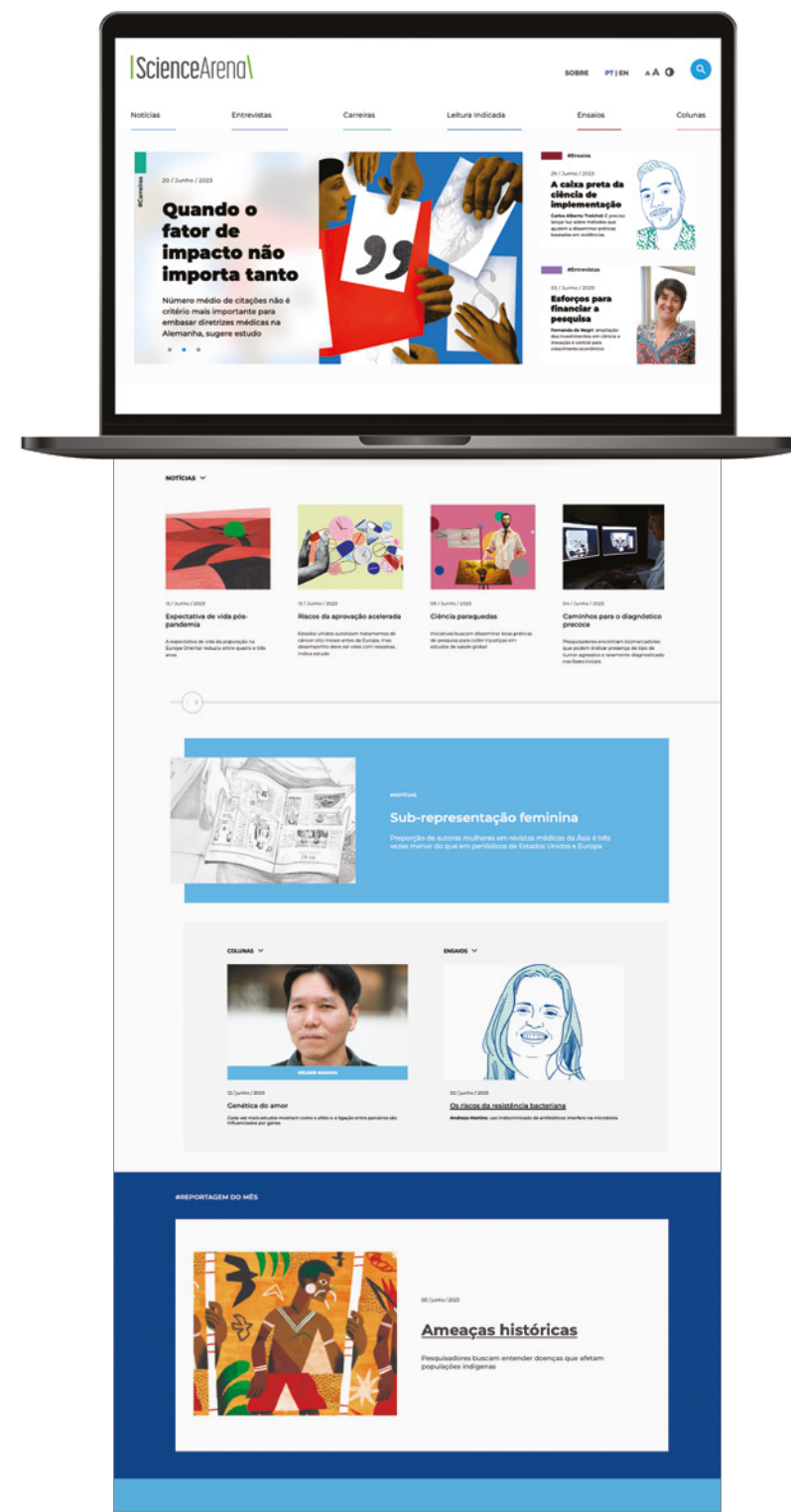
